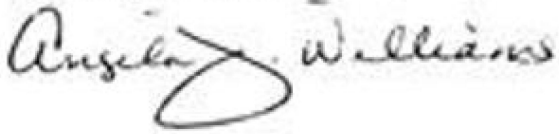

Dear Council Members:

The Elmira City Court is a part of the New York State Unified Court System. Pursuant to the Judiciary Law of the State of New York, the City is required to provide suitable facilities and certain services, including janitorial services. The cost for said services is paid by the City.

Chapter 686 of the Laws of 1996 authorized the State, through the Unified Court System, to reimburse the City 100% for expenses incurred in providing the cleaning services and the City's performance of minor repairs, and 25% for maintenance to the court facilities.

To be eligible for the reimbursement, the City is required to enter into a Contract Renewal Letter agreement with the New York State Unified Court System covering the period FY April 1, 2020 through March 31, 2021. The following resolution authorizes the Mayor to execute the Contract Renewal Letter agreement by which the City agrees to provide the cleaning services and the State agrees to reimburse the City in accordance with the State law adopted in 1996.
