Dear Councilmembers:

Arnot Realty Corporation (Petitioner) filed petitions in Chemung County Supreme Court challenging the assessment on its property located at 100 E. Church Street, Tax Map Parcel No. 89.19-3-8 pertaining to the 2019 Tax Assessment Roll. The Tax Assessment Roll sets an assessment of \$1,590,000 for the Tax Map Parcel. After negotiations with Petitioner's representatives and upon review by the City Assessor, the parties have reached an agreement subject to Council's approval to settle the legal proceeding by adjusting the assessment as follows:

2019 Assessment \$1,590,000

Revised Assessment \$1,150,000

This reduction results in the City refunding to Petitioner the approximate amount of \$11,880 for tax year 2020.
